

Dornoch Whisky Festival Grand Tasting Exhibitor Terms and Conditions

These are the standard terms and conditions of the Dornoch Whisky Festival, which is registered at:

C/O: Royal Dornoch Golf Club, Golf Road, Dornoch, IV25 3LW.

These terms and conditions apply to exhibitors attending the Grand Tasting at the Dornoch Whisky Festival 2025.

- 1. Event Booking Details
- 1.1 All bookings will be regarded as provisional until a signed copy of the **Dornoch Whisky Festival Exhibitors Form** is returned. The Dornoch Whisky Festival is not obligated to hold provisional bookings beyond the closure date stated in the exhibitor pack.
- 2. Price & Payment
- 2.1 All prices quoted must be paid in full by Monday 29th September 2025.
- 2.2 Any queries arising from an invoice must be submitted in writing within 10 working days of receipt.
- 2.3 The exhibitor representative confirming the booking is responsible for ensuring all relevant parties are aware of the payment terms.
- 2.4 Late bookings made within **20 working days** of the event must be paid in full at the time of confirmation.
- 2.5 Accepted Payment Methods:

Exhibitors must notify the Dornoch Whisky Festival in writing when a bank transfer has been made.

- 3. Cancellation
- 3.1 Cancellations by exhibitors must be **made in writing** and will be subject to the following charges:
 - More than 60 days before the event: No charge
 - 41 to 60 days before the event: 50% of total fee
 - 32 to 40 days before the event: 80% of total fee
 - 31 days or fewer before the event: 100% of total fee



- 3.2 In the event of a cancellation or postponement due to a Public Health Emergency or force majeure, payments received may be credited towards a future event, subject to availability and within 12 months of the original date.
- 4. Licencing
- 4.1 All alcohol sales at the event must be **authorised** by a **Personal Licence Holder** with responsibility for the exhibitor's trade stand.
- 4.2 All staff serving alcohol must either:
 - Hold a Personal Licence, or
 - Have completed the legally required staff training in alcohol sales.
- 4.3 Exhibitors must comply with all licensing laws and are responsible for ensuring their staff understand and follow the legal requirements.
- 4.4 The Dornoch Whisky Festival operates a **strict responsible drinking policy**, including a **voucher system** for pours, details of which are provided separately.
- 5. Liability
- 5.1 The Dornoch Whisky Festival, its employees, and volunteers shall not be liable for:
 - Loss, damage, or delay to exhibitor property.
 - Any injury, loss, or claim resulting from exhibitor participation, except where caused by direct negligence of the festival.
- 5.2 Exhibitors must have adequate Public Liability Insurance covering their attendance.
- 5.3 The exhibitor **agrees to indemnify** the Dornoch Whisky Festival against any **claims**, **losses**, **or damages** arising from their participation.
- 6. Exhibitor Setup & Responsibilities
- 6.1 Exhibitor setup begins at 10:00 AM.
- 6.2 Exhibitors must be fully set up by 11:00 AM and ready to welcome guests.
- 6.3 Exhibitors are responsible for their own transport, stock, and display materials.
- 6.4 **Power supply is not guaranteed**. If power is required, exhibitors must inform the Dornoch Whisky Festival in advance.
- 6.5 Exhibitors must ensure their area is **kept tidy** and that all waste is disposed of properly.
- 7. Selling Products at the Event
- 7.1 Exhibitors may **sell whisky and related products** at the event, provided all sales comply with licensing laws.



- 7.2 Exhibitors are responsible for handling their own payments (cash or card).
- 7.3 **Wi-Fi availability is not guaranteed**. Exhibitors are advised to bring their own **mobile hotspot** if required.
- 8. Force Majeure
- 8.1 The Dornoch Whisky Festival **shall not be liable** for any delay or failure to perform obligations due to:
 - Acts of God
 - Strikes, lockouts, or industrial disputes
 - Pandemic-related restrictions
 - Fire, flood, or other natural disasters
 - Acts of war or terrorism
- 8.2 In such circumstances, the event may be postponed or cancelled, and refunds or credits will be considered on a case-by-case basis.
- 9. Data Protection & Privacy
- 9.1 Exhibitor details will be stored **securely** and used solely for festival communication.
- 9.2 The Dornoch Whisky Festival does not share exhibitor data with third parties, except where necessary for event coordination.
- 9.3 Exhibitors consent to being included in festival marketing unless they opt out in writing.
- 10. Severance
- 10.1 If any term in these Terms & Conditions is deemed **invalid**, **illegal**, **or unenforceable**, the remainder shall **remain in full effect**
- 11. Governing Law
- 11.1 These Terms & Conditions shall be **governed by Scottish law** and subject to the **exclusive jurisdiction of the Scottish courts**.
