



Carnegie Whisky Cellars

Located in the Carnegie Courthouse in the heart of Dornoch, the Carnegie Whisky Cellars opened in June 2016 and has quickly earned a reputation for outstanding service and product knowledge. Their commitment to quality ensures that each visitor receives a warm welcome and expert guidance. If you're unsure what to choose, they will gladly guide you through various flavour profiles to help you find the right match, whether that's a fine whisky or a perfectly paired bottle of wine. Their shelves are filled with carefully curated selections, showcasing local favourites alongside unique finds from further afield. The inviting Vaultroom is ideal for enjoying a dram and provides a fitting venue for Dornoch Whisky Festival events, including their seasonal special Hocus Pocus, Local Focus, which celebrates the incredible whiskies in our local area.

Dornoch Castle Hotel

Much has changed at the Dornoch Castle Hotel, which is believed to date back to the 15th century. Guests can settle in by the original fireplace in their renowned Whisky Bar, sip a dram, and soak up the hotel's rich history. The bar team are always happy to share their knowledge, whether you're browsing the shelves for something special or deciding what to try from the menu.

Their restaurant continues to celebrate the best of Highland produce, with dishes that showcase quality, seasonality, and creativity. Be sure to join them for their **Paired Whisky Dinner: Adelphi X Ardnamurchan,** featuring a carefully crafted menu matched with exceptional whiskies to create an unforgettable evening.

Dornoch Distillery

Dornoch Distillery, founded by brothers Simon and Philip Thompson in 2016, began with a successful crowdfunding campaign to bring back the character and flavour of older whisky styles. Since then, they've released a range of highly regarded independent bottlings, along with organic gin and blended Scotch whiskies. Their own Dornoch Single Malt releases continue to earn praise for quality and craftsmanship. This year marks an exciting new chapter as the Thompsons move forward with Struie, their planned new distillery just a short distance from the original site. Designed with sustainability and growth in mind, Struie will allow them to increase production while staying true to their traditional methods and experimental spirit.

Dornoch Station Hotel

Dornoch Station is a beautifully restored Highland hotel that blends contemporary style with traditional charm. Reimagined in 2023, the hotel now features elegant rooms, inviting lounges and stunning views across the links and the Dornoch Firth.

Its restaurant, The Golden Gorse, celebrates local ingredients and seasonal produce, while Bar Ross offers a relaxed space to enjoy a dram, cocktail or glass of wine. The atmosphere is refined yet welcoming, making it an ideal addition to your visit. Surrounded by sea air, open skies and the sound of the links, it captures the calm and character that make Dornoch so special. This year, join them for their From Founding to Finish tasting, exploring the evolution of the Scottish whisky industry.

Links House at Royal Dornoch

Nestled beside the first tee at Royal Dornoch, Links House is a boutique hotel offering luxury with a warm Highland welcome. Once a 19th-century manse, it now features beautifully styled rooms and elegant lounges.

At the heart of Links House is MARA, where local ingredients and Highland spirits take centre stage. Their team are passionate about pairings, guiding guests through whisky and wine flights and flavour experiences that showcase the best of the region.

This year, join them for their Whisky Supper Club, a beautifully crafted tasting menu paired with whiskies from Gordon & MacPhail, presented by quest Stephen Rankin.

The Eagle Hotel

Centrally located on Castle Street, the Eagle Hotel stands as Dornoch's first and only bar with rooms. It offers an impressive selection of real ales, craft lagers, and a vast collection of Scottish gin, alongside more than one hundred and fifty whiskies, including locally crafted gems. Their range of rum further enhances the experience. The Eagle is renowned for its hospitality, delicious food, and inviting atmosphere, as well as its close connections with local distilleries. A favourite with both locals and visitors, the Eagle remains a true gathering place at the heart of Dornoch. This year, join Eric, the enthusiastic landlord and whisky collector, for his popular Indy Bottling, where he'll unveil drams from his personal collection - a relaxed evening of whisky appreciation and good company.

Royal Dornoch Golf Club

Royal Dornoch Golf Club has been part of the town's story for centuries, its origins tracing back to 1616. Known across the world for its Championship Course, the club continues to honour its rich heritage while looking to the future with the development of its new clubhouse. Set beside the Dornoch Firth, it remains a place where history, community and hospitality meet.

During the festival, the clubhouse will host Whisky Bingo, an evening filled with drams, laughter and friendly competition. It's the perfect opportunity to experience Royal Dornoch's warm welcome and enjoy a memorable night in one of Scotland's most iconic settings.

Festival by the Thompson Bros, this Glen Scotia
2014 from a Refill Bourbon Barrel sits at 53.7% ABV,
with just 160 bottles available. Priced at £60, it's a
dram that captures the spirit of our 10th
anniversary perfectly; distinctive, characterful, and
made to be shared.

We're delighted that the proceeds from this year's bottling will go straight back into the Dornoch Whisky Festival, helping us make future years even better.
